Response:

GKCE possesses an honoured right to endorse advanced technical education, and to ensure women empowerment through gender equality. To promote women education, the Institute makes consistent efforts.

The Institute organizes several training programs, seminars, workshops etc. on gender equality and sensitization. Recently Mahila police group interacted with girls' community of GKCE to bring awareness about the Disha app suggested by the Andhra Government in the first week of October 2021. Women' grievance redressal committee of GKCE is meant to safe guard and promote wellbeing of all women employees and students of the college. The cell is responsible for looking into any complaints filed by students & staff about women grievance at college. Students are allowed to file the complaint through mobile also(online).

Objectives of Women' grievance redressal committee of GKCE:

Women grievance redressal cell is a growing community of women in GKCE which share a common purpose to learn, educate and collaborate on ideas that have the power to effect meaningful and positive change while fighting the challenges they face.

- To investigate reported cases of sexual harassment of women, if any and submit its report to the disciplinary authority recommending action to be taken against the accused miscreants.
- To hold meetings regularly.
- To organise various functions acquainting the women regarding their rights.
- To equip the female students, faculty and staff members with knowledge of their legal rights.
- To safe guard the rights of female students, faculty and staff members.
- To provide a platform for listening to complaints & redressal of grievance.
- To incorporate hygiene habits and ensure a healthy atmosphere in and around college.

International Women's Day is also celebrated every year and women celebrity are invited to address the girl students. In 2021, Smt. Shaik Faizunnisa. B. Sc, LLM (Constitutional & administrative law), Additional judicial Magistrate of first-class court, Sullurpet inspired the students with her speech and interacted with women faculty and students to create awareness about the rights of a girl child and a woman right in the society.

The Institute has also ensured gender equality in representation of women in all top positions. The IQAC, CSE Department, NSS are all headed by women.

Makar Sankranti is an Indian festival celebrated by several states of India around mid-January. This festival is celebrated in honor of Surya (the Sun God) to pay tribute for the grace of his energy that has enabled life and food on earth. As it is the harvest festival, it is a time of joy, abundance, and celebration in the farming communities, the time when they reap the fruits of their hard labor. We celebrated the Makara Sankranti celebrations in our college campus on 11-01-2023, with different competitions like Rangoli, Sugar cane breaking, Traditional dress wear and Kite flying.
